

**MORPHOLOGY AND ANATOMY OF *CHICOREUS BRUNNEUS* (LINK,1807):  
DESCRIPTION OF SHELL AND SOFT PART**

**ABSTRACT**

Shell and soft body of the muricid gastropod *Chicoreus brunneus* (Link 1807) are described in detail. The shells display variation in colour, especially at the columella lip. The soft body and radula are similar in morphology and anatomy to other species of the genus *Chicoreus*: buccal channel reaches the mouth, bipectinate osphradium with rectangular lamellae, rachidian rasula, prominent gland of Leiblein, and females possess a penis and vas deferens of about half the size of the same organs in males.
