

**MOLLUSCS FROM BEACHES ON BALI, LOMBOK, SUMBAWA, AND
KOMODO ISLANDS , INDONESIA**

ABSTRACT

A total of 131 taxa of gastropods, bivalves and cephalopods were recorded by participants in the 9th TMMP Congress and Workshop. The material does not represent a systematic collection; rather the identifications reflect a limited number of study sites and taxonomic interests of the participants. The families Conidae, Littorinidae, Neritidae, Muricidae, and Olividae are well represented among the gastropods, and Cardiidae is well represented among the bivalves. Only 3 taxa (all cardiids) were recorded on all 4 islands; 10 species of gastropods (littorinids and lottidids) were recorded on both sides of the strait between Bali and Lombok (Wallace's Line), while the remaining taxa were recorded either to the east or the west of this strait.
