ABSTRACT

Forty-five species of gastropods in 27 genera were collected along transect lines and identified. A total of 35 species were associated with hard substrata and 10 species with soft sediment. Four species have commercial value: *Haliotis uaria*, *Trochus niloticus*, *Lambis lambis*, and *Pleuroploca trapezium*. *Trochus niloticus* has been declared endangered species by The Indonesian Minister of Forestry.
