

# **BIVALVIA COLLECTED FROM THE ISLANDS OF SUNDASTRAITS**

Fifty seven species of molluscs collected from the reef flat (intertidal areas) of four coral islands around Bnggano Island, Indian Ocean consisted of 41 species of gastropods and 16 species of bivalves. A systematic list is provided with illustrations, brief description and brief ecological notes on the habitat. The family Strombidae was dominated by the genus *Lambis*. Among the bivalve families Tridacnidae had the highest number of specimens. Two species of mangrove bivalves were also collected.
