

**NEW RECORDS OF MARINE CERITHIID MICROGASTROPODS  
(PROSOBRANCHIA: CERITHIIDAE) FROM THAI WATERS**

**ABSTRACT:** Specimens of marine cerithiid microgastropod were collected in Thai Waters from the South China Sea (Gulf of Thailand) and the Indian Ocean (Andaman Sea). Two genera, comprising four species were recorded, including *Bittium glareosum* Gould, 1861, *B. simplex* (Jeffreys, 1867), *Cerithium alutaceum* (Gould, 1861) and *C. stigmatosum* Gould, 1861. All were recorded in Thai Waters and the Andaman Sea for the first time. The latter three species were new records for the Indian Ocean.
